

# Release notes for November/December 2015 StatCrunch updates

## Major additions:

- The new StatCrunch session-saving feature, which saves results and settings along with data, was released. See [https://www.statcrunch.com/5.0/example.php?example\\_id=100](https://www.statcrunch.com/5.0/example.php?example_id=100) for details.
- Better resizing behavior was added so that StatCrunch output will never go offscreen when the browser window is resized. See page 2 for details.

## Minor fixes and enhancements:

- Minor bugs were fixed for the contingency table and sampling distribution applets.

# Repositioning/resizing StatCrunch output when the browser is resized

The StatCrunch data table has always resized properly when the browser window is resized. It was possible, however, for portions of StatCrunch output to be hidden offscreen if the browser window was made smaller. StatCrunch output now responds to browser resizing in a more responsive manner. As the browser window is resized, StatCrunch output will be repositioned so that it remains visible if possible. If the browser is made smaller than the output, the output will then be resized to fit within the browser window. The example below illustrates this behavior. The first screenshot shows a histogram displayed within StatCrunch, and the second screenshot shows the repositioning/resizing of the histogram after the browser is resized to much smaller dimensions.
